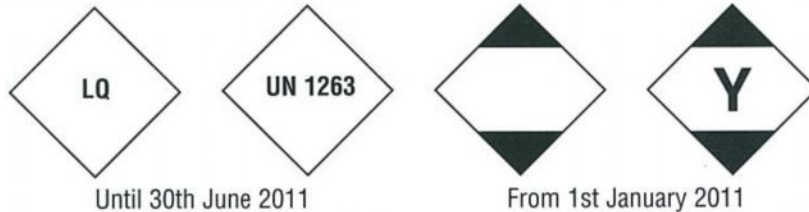

ADR 2011 – Limited quantities and Excepted quantities

Please note the changes to Limited quantities and Excepted quantities.

3.2 Limited Quantities

For limited quantities if the packages display the following labels they will not contribute to the load threshold limit.



For vehicles with a gross weight exceeding 12 tonnes when carrying Limited Quantities with a gross weight exceeding 8 tonnes then the following vehicle sign must be displayed at the front and rear of the vehicle, except when the vehicle is marked with orange plates. Containers require the Limited Quantity sign on all 4 sides, unless already marked with class placards.



3.3 Excepted Quantities



If the packages are displaying this sign they are classified as Excepted Quantities. Drivers of vehicles carrying these (and no other dangerous goods) only require general awareness training. No other sections of ADR relating to the carrier apply. The maximum number of these packages that can be carried is 1000.
